KIDS' CHANCE OF PENNSYLVANIA HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2007

- Kids' Chance of PA celebrates 10th Anniversary providing scholarships to children of injured workers.

- Governor Rendell congratulates Kids' Chance on the celebration of its 10th anniversary and commends all involved with Kids' Chance for their compassion and activism.

- Kids' Chance hosts 2nd annual recognition event and golf outing, raising over \$10,000 for scholarship grants.

- Kids' Chance launches The Scholars Program where sponsor will contribute a minimum of \$25,000 over a period of not more than five years. As a Scholars Program sponsor, an organization may name its scholarship and recommend that it be awarded to a student pursuing a particular field of study.

- The ACE INA Foundation continues to support Kids' Chance by joining the Scholars program with a grant of \$25,000 a year for 5 years.

- Eastern Alliance Insurance Group & Universal SmartComp joined the Scholars Program with grants of \$5,000 a year for five years.






KIDS' CHANCE WELCOMES PIERSON, DISHNER AND CARBONI TO THE BOARD.
