KIDS' CHANCE OF PENNSYLVANIA HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2006

- Governor Edward G. Rendell continues to endorse Kids' Chance of Pennsylvania and remains Honorary Chairman of the Board.
- The ACE Foundation continues to support Kids' Chance of Pennsylvania and the Kids' Chance ACE INA Scholars Program. This year, a grant of \$25,000 provided awards of \$5,000 each to five ACE INA Scholars.
- Kids' Chance of Pennsylvania received a second grant of \$7,500 from the Lenfest Foundation.
- Through a partnership with PATH (Partnership For Access To Higher Education), a state matching program, Kids' Chance of Pennsylvania will leverage a maximum of \$16,000 in matching funds for this year's scholarship grant recipients with remaining unmet financial need. Last year, over \$15,000 in PATH matching funds was secured for 15 eligible Kids' Chance grant recipients.
- Kids' Chance has broadened its base of support through the Corporate and Community Partner program. Currently there are 29 Partners representing a variety of organizations, many related to workers' compensation.
