We are pleased to report that the Board of Directors elected the **Honorable Elizabeth Crum** as President-Elect. Liz will “shadow” Chris Davis for the remainder of the year and step up when Chris’ term expires on December 31, 2019. Here’s a little info about our new President-Elect:

For over 30 years, Liz Crum served the Commonwealth of Pa, Department of Labor and Industry in a variety of positions. Most recently, she was Director of the Workers’ Compensation Office of Adjudication (WCOA) with management responsibilities for Pennsylvania’s workers’ compensation judges, judge managers and staff in 22 offices located throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Prior to assuming the Director’s position, Ms. Crum was Deputy Secretary for Compensation and Insurance with oversight responsibilities for the State Workers’ Compensation Insurance Fund (SWIF), WCOA, the Bureau of Workers’ Compensation (BWC) and the Bureau of Disability Determination (BDD). She also served as Judge Manager for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania and as a Judge in Philadelphia and Harrisburg. Prior to her appointment as Judge, she served as an attorney and Chief of the Compliance Division with BWC. She began her legal career as an attorney/advisor with the U.S. Department of Labor in Pittsburgh, and is a 1987 graduate of the University of Pittsburgh School of Law. She is a consultant in areas such as: workers’ compensation information technology, mediation processes and procedures, risk management and education.
